March Meeting Minutes were approved.

President Report

- AG Clubs need Mr. Folk to communicate with Ms. Staton and teachers about how they work (how they are funded, signup, etc.). We need to ask Bulldog Club or Ms. Goodrum to help fund supplies for Touchdown Club. Due to teacher change we have a money discrepancy with Minecraft Club. - Course Registration event tonight is informational for rising 7/8th parents. Student's will review their course cards in their 1st block classes.
- Chrome books are here. Need to be processed, labeled and into inventory. Waiting on the carts that go with them.
- Campus beautification is underway. Drainage issues already appear to be fixed. Should be finished in the next few weeks. Need to ask for help to water throughout the summer. Campus beautification is going to order the supplies needed and Amy is going to ask F3 to help a few

times a week. Total bill was \$18,210. We are paying them in installments as Invest \$ comes in.

- Neighborhood nandina planting is finished. 130 bushes were planted. They raised funds through the Barclay Downs homeowners association and are channeling the \$ through our PTO. The bushes were \$3850. They have raised \$2300 thus far.
